Notes to equestrian participants: there are stalls for up to 40 horses in the horse camping area. Once these stalls have been spoken for, there will be no further horses accepted. If you think there is no way that 40 stalls will be spoken for don't be so sure. With the interest expressed so far, we are expecting a very large number of horses and riders this year.

Although formal proof of vaccinations is not required for this site, the veterinarian on call wishes to advise SCA equestrians that West Nile vaccinations are recommended in the area this year.

There is a reasonable amount of room for camping in the horse area for those who wish to camp near their warhorses. The stalls are 12 X12 standing panel stalls, without gates. This means some sort of tie for each stall is recommended. Tied lead ropes work fine. There is potable water available in the horse camping area but you will need to bring your own buckets for in the stalls. The weather may be inclement (this is Oregon in the early Spring, after all) so please consider bringing rain or winter turn out sheets for you horses as the stalls do not have any form of cover. There is a feed store 5 minutes from the event where grass hay, alfalfa and feed can be purchased.

The site has 30 acres of private cross country style trails and an indoor arena, as well as a massive outdoor arena. ([see the site map](#)). All of these areas will be used for event activities, *weather permitting*.

The entire site is an area subject to SCA insurance when horses are exposed to humans– all entering gate must sign the equestrian waiver.

Pre-registration

Fill out one copy of the Equestrian pre-registration form for each group bringing horses to the event.

Costs for the event are... \$15 for Adults, \$10 for youth, 12 and under no charge, \$40 family Cap (Immediate family only, excluding horses and the non-member surcharge). There is a \$5/person non-member surcharge for adults.

There IS a separate fee of \$15 per night, per horse to be paid to the site owners. All equestrian participants MUST pre-register. We encourage payment with pre-registration to speed up getting through gate.

Please PRINT CLEARLY and LEGIBLY. You may photocopy the form, but do not reduce or enlarge it. Do not substitute or staple the form.

When we receive your registration, we will e-mail back an acknowledgement of your Equestrian registration. Please print and bring this acknowledgement with you when you arrive at the gate. Forms should be postmarked by April 1, 2010.

Please include a photo copy of membership cards and riders authorization cards for all people listed in this pre-registration.
